Our lessons will begin on Wednesday, July 10^h, at 5:30 p. m., at Rouge Park and will run every Wednesday through August 7th. Lessons begin at 5:30 p.m. and end at 8:00 p.m. Not only do we teach our children about the basics of the game: putting, chipping and full swing; we also provide them with discussions on golf etiquette and Christian principles of life.

All equipment and golf balls are provided. All children receive golf shirts and trophies. We also recognize the Best Golfer in each age group. We do not turn any child away and we will teach all children from ages 4 to 17.

The program will end with our 17th Annual William (Bill) Morgan Golf Outing where we take the children out to play a round of golf.
