

Delores Ivory-Davis **Interim Director**

Delores Ivory-Davis is a product of the Detroit Public School System. She graduated from Cass Technical High School, and attended Wayne State University, graduating with a Bachelor of Science degree in Music Education. After having taught for one year Ms.Ivory-Davis moved to New York City.

While living in New York, Ms.Ivory-Davis auditioned for and joined the Houston Opera Company that mounted productions of Porgy and Bess all over the world. Some of the countries in which she performed were Australia, New Zealand, France, Italy, Spain, Germany and the United States, which included an extended run on Broadway. During this run, Ms.Ivory-Davis was nominated for a Drama Desk Award for Best Supporting Actress in a Broadway Musical

Ms.Ivory-Davis toured for twenty years with the Houston Opera then returned to Detroit to teach music in the Detroit Public Schools before retiring in 1999.

Ms.Ivory-Davis has been a part of the Music Staff of Hartford Church for almost twenty years. In August 2011 she was appointed interim director of the Cathedral Choir, where she will serve until a permanent director is found.
