SOCIAL JUSTICE CORNER: ELECTION NEWS: 2026

MICHIGAN'S STATEWIDE PRIMARY IS TUESDAY, AUGUST 4.

- ◆ On Election Day, polls are open from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m.
- ◆ The mandatory early voting period — when local communities are required to offer early, **in-person voting** — **for the primary election, runs from Saturday, July 25, through Sunday, Aug. 2.** Hours for early voting will vary by location. In Michigan, eligible voters can also submit absentee ballots to vote by mail.

MICHIGAN'S GENERAL ELECTION IS TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3.

- ◆ Polls again will be open on Election Day from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m. **The mandatory early voting period runs from Saturday, Oct. 24, through Sunday, Nov. 1.**

Michigan voters will get to decide on:

- Governor:
- U.S. Senator:
- U.S. House of Representatives
- Legislature: All 110 seats in the Michigan House of Representatives and 38 seats in the Michigan Senate are up for election.
- Secretary of State:

- A Constitutional Convention? Michigan's constitution requires voters to decide every 16 years whether it's time to rewrite it. Michigan's current constitution has been in place since 1963, and voters have rejected rewriting it three times since then.
