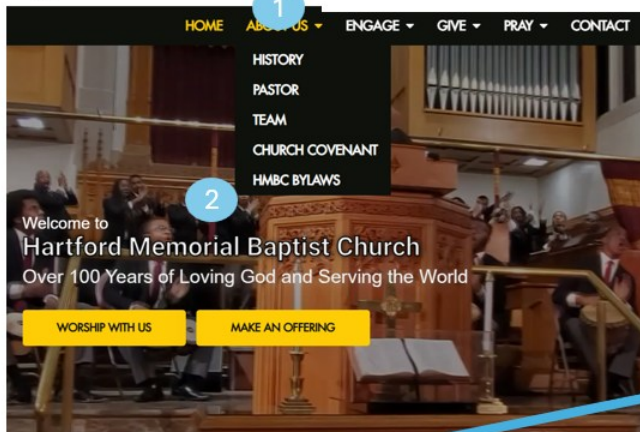

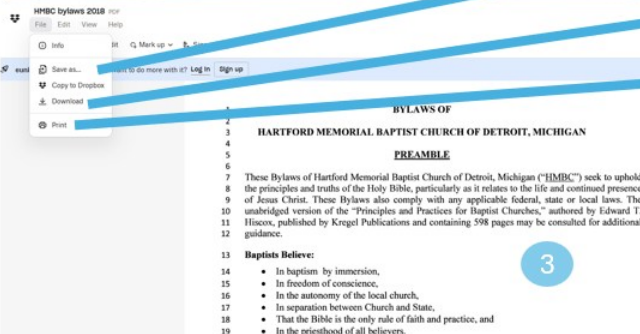

- ◆ Polls will be open on Election Day from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m. **The mandatory early voting period runs from Saturday, Oct. 24, through Sunday, Nov. 1.**

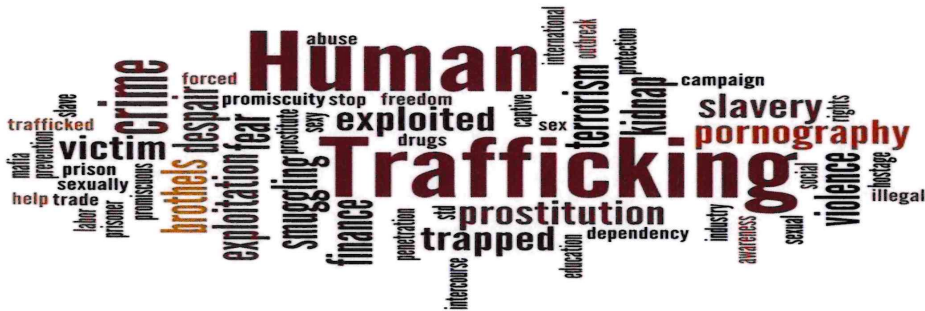
Michigan voters will get to decide on:

- Governor:
 - U.S. Senator:
 - U.S. House of Representatives
 - Legislature: All 110 seats in the Michigan House of Representatives and 38 seats in the Michigan Senate are up for election.
 - Secretary of State:
 - Attorney General:
 - Two Michigan Supreme Court seats:
 - A Constitutional Convention? Michigan's constitution requires voters to decide every 16 years whether it's time to rewrite it. Michigan's current constitution has been in place since 1963, and voters have rejected rewriting it three times since then.

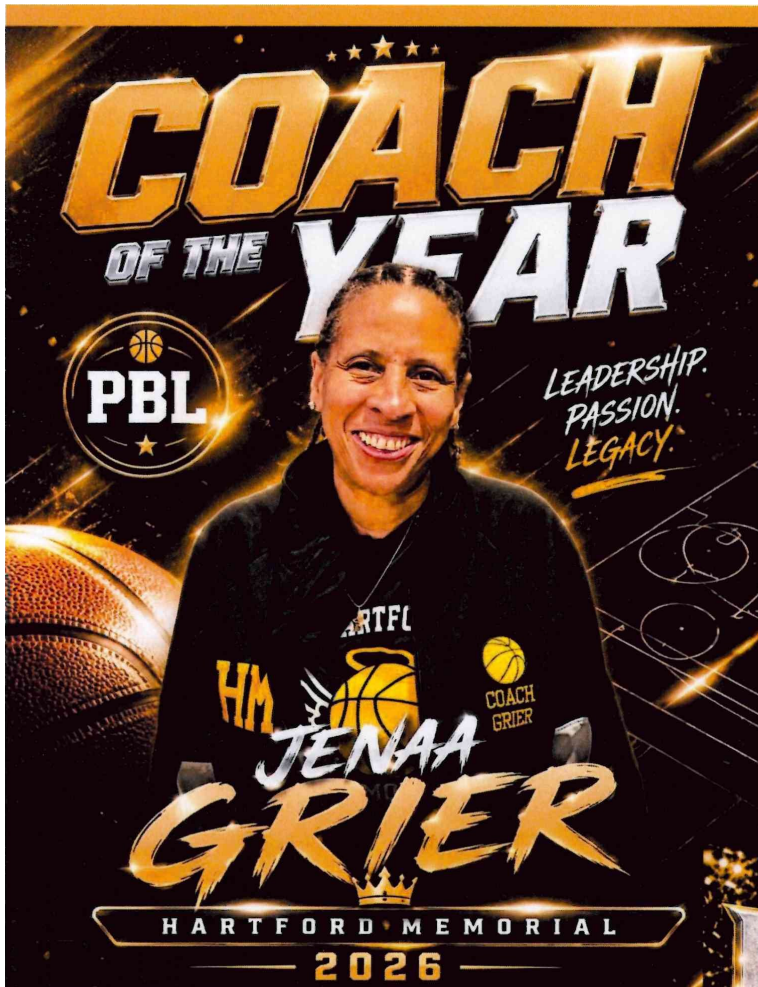

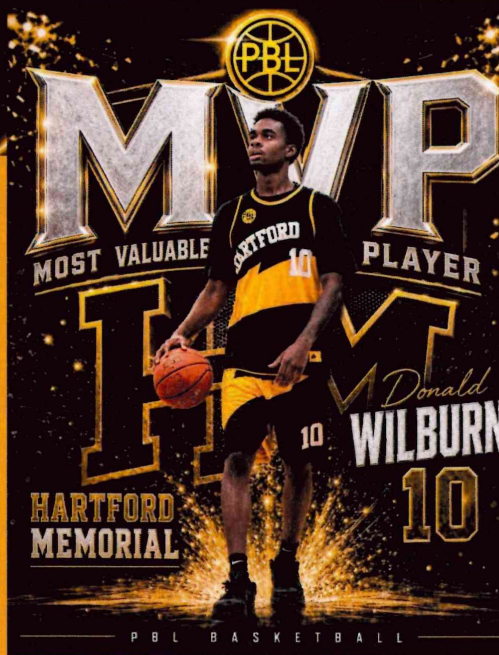
