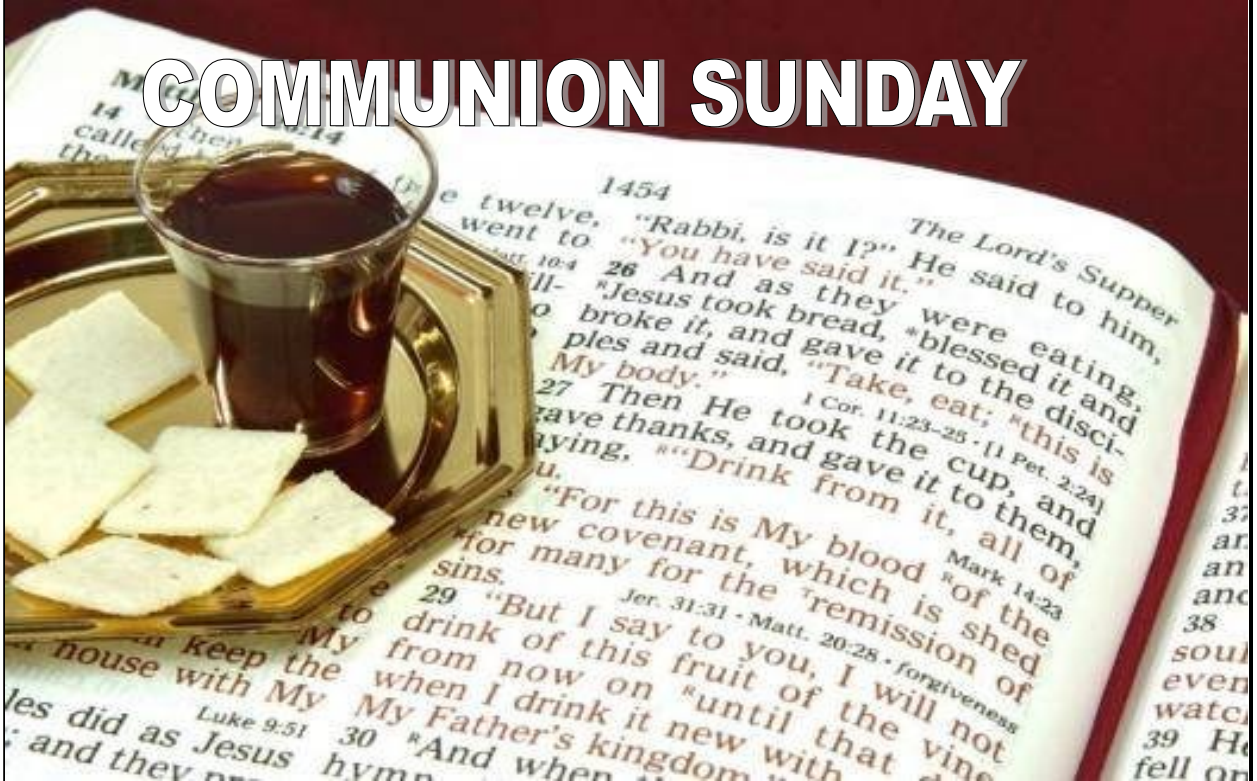

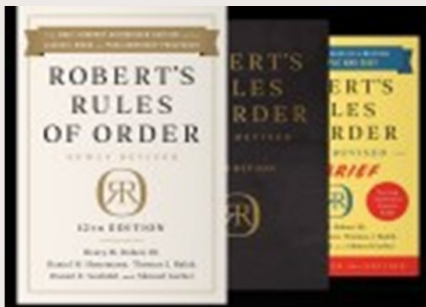

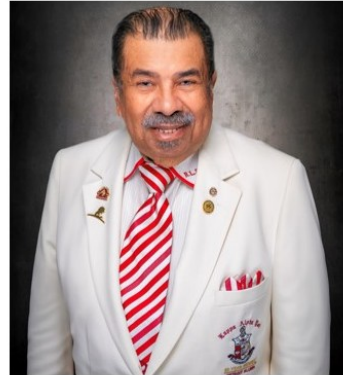

Gleaners Community Food Bank is joining the HMBC Food Pantry to offer supplemental groceries to our neighbors.

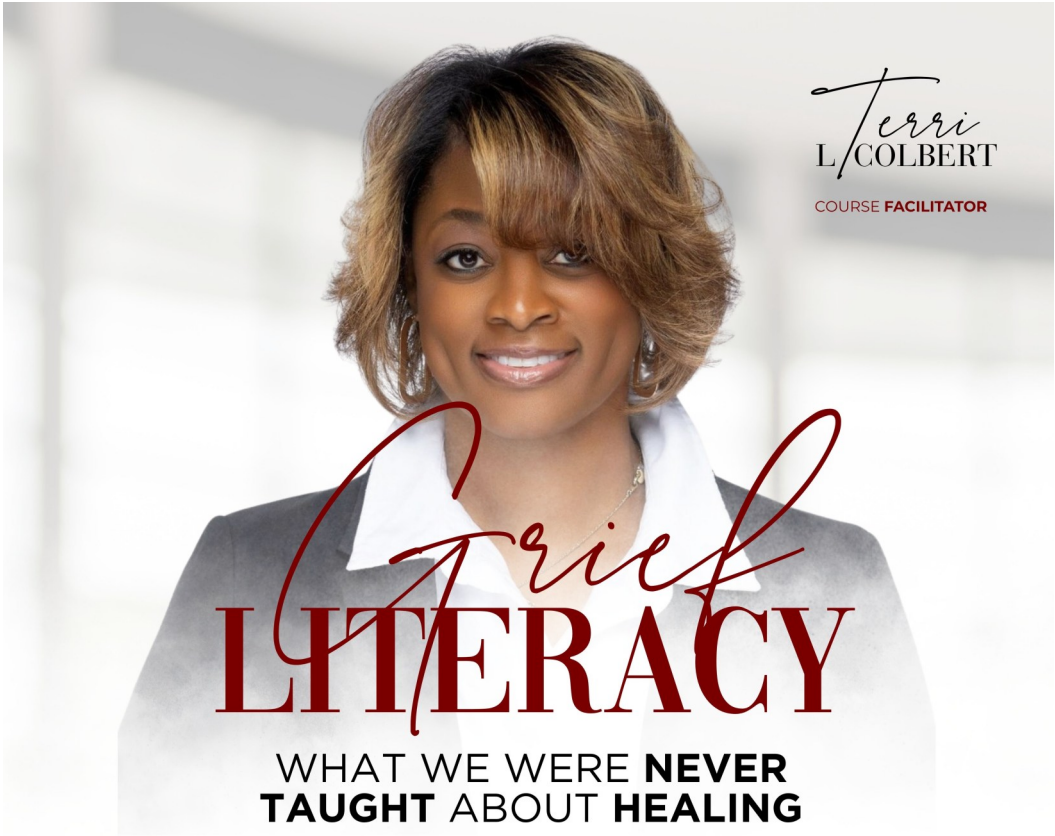
